

STATE OFFICE REPRESENTATIVE

1. Shall discuss State Child Nutrition Program Policies with the President and the Executive board of SNAU and keep them up to date on any regulation changes.
2. Be the liaison between SNAU and the State Office of Education.
3. Serves as a voting member of the SNAU Executive Board
4. Attend LAC and participate in preparing and presenting educational materials prior to the conference and for use in other state meetings.
5. Promote association membership and other association activities.
6. If requested, travel with the group representing SNA to Area Meetings.
7. Be a responsible party in building and keeping the relationship/partnership with SNAU healthy and heading in the right direction.
8. Attend and serve as a voting member of the House of Delegates, or send and alternate if you cannot attend
9. Submit a written report to the SNAU President by May 1st to be included in the House of Delegates folder.
